- **Optional:** Candidates will be eligible for the School District Leader (SDL) certificate at the end of semester IV, assuming that all program requirements have been met and the candidate has achieved passing scores on the required New York State School District Leader assessments(s). Additionally, evidence of completing the School Violence and Reporting & Identifying Child Abuse & Maltreatment workshops must be provided. *Please note: if you plan on taking the exam communicate with your advisor when you begin this program.*
- Candidates must submit their final dissertation to the Proquest research database.
- Candidates must complete the program of study within six years after acceptance;
- Candidates must complete all requirements of the IRB prior to graduation;
- Candidates must apply for graduation through Student Services Office: February 1 (May), June 1 (August), October 1 (Dec); *Applications may be obtained at student services or on-line at [www.sage.edu](http://www.sage.edu).*
- Candidates must complete a criminal background check with fingerprinting, as required by New York State law;
